

Senior Trips

Members of the senior class of each high school shall be permitted to take a class trip before graduation, subject to the following guidelines:

1. Plans for the proposed trip must be submitted for approval to the Superintendent or his/her designee by March 15.
2. Approved plans for the trip, including itinerary, must be reviewed by the bus garage supervisor for final approval at least two weeks before departure.
3. All financial costs of the trips shall be paid by the senior class. A reasonable fee for participation and transportation can be charged. Transportation shall be in District vehicles.
4. Sponsorship shall include one (1) adult sponsor for every ten (10) students.
5. All school rules and regulations shall apply, i.e., discipline, smoking, alcohol, etc.
6. A statement of acknowledgement of this policy will be received from the parents at least one day prior to departure.
7. Overnight trips are discouraged.
8. There will be no special fundraising to promote or defray expenses of the trip. All unexpended funds, after allowances are made concerning graduation expenses and activities, will revert to the general student activity fund. The senior class may dedicate the use of these remaining funds for special purposed or activities.
9. Parents may help serve as sponsors during the trip.
